

HOW TO GET TO CRITICAL EXPOSURE

Critical Exposure is located in the Thurgood Marshall Center, right by the U. St. Metro (green and yellow lines).

From the metro: Exit at 13th and U St. Then turn right and walk away from the Starbucks towards 12th St. Turn right on 12th St. and walk 1.5 blocks. We're in the big building on the right-hand side. Buzz at the front door to be let in, then sign in and the front desk and say you're here for Critical Exposure.

From the 90, 92, 93 and 96 bus: Exit at 13th and U St. Then turn right and walk away from the Starbucks towards 12th St. Turn right on 12th St. and walk 1.5 blocks. We're in the big building on the right-hand side. Buzz at the front door to be let in, then sign in and the front desk and say you're here for Critical Exposure.

From the 64 bus: Get off at 11th and S St. Walk down S St. towards Garrison Elementary School. Buzz at the front door to be let in, then sign in and the front desk and say you're here for Critical Exposure.
