## **SUMMARY**

Prohibits State Board of Education from requiring, and school districts from administering, certain assessments to students enrolled or preparing to enroll in prekindergarten through grade two. Makes exception for assessments administered for diagnostic purposes as required under state or federal law.

  - best practices of administering statewide assessments of students. The

- 9 kindergarten] through grade eight and who has met or exceeded state stan-
- dards on a test is excused from being required to retake the test.
  - (2)(a) Except for assessments that are required to be administered for diagnostic purposes under state or federal law:
- 13 (A) The State Board of Education may not develop an assessment
- 14 for or require a school district to administer a state-developed assess-
- 15 ment, a commercially developed assessment or another comparable

- 3 (b) As used in this subsection, "commercially developed assessment" means an assessment that:
- 5 (A) Requires all test takers to answer the same questions, or a 6 portion of questions selected from all possible questions, in the same 7 manner; and
  - (B) That is developed and scored by an entity under a contract.
  - (c) Nothing in this subsection prohibits a classroom teacher from selecting, developing, administering or scoring an assessment for an individual classroom in any subject area in prekindergarten through grade two.
